#### Financial and Activity Report (sheet 2 of 2) Short bulleted list of the major actions taken to date Short bulleted list of the major planned actions The Department of Defense (DoD) had a net increase in obligations of \$70.9M for the week ending October 21, 2011, resulting in Continue to award contracts and monitor execution. cumulative obligations of the Recovery Act funds of \$6,874.6M, which is 95.8% of appropriated DoD Recovery Act funds. This includes \$3,972.7M for the Facilities Sustainment, Restoration and Modernization (FSRM) program; \$1,932.8M for the Military Construction (MILCON) program including \$70.9M in new obligations for the week; \$117.4M for the Energy Conservation Investment Program (ECIP); \$296.8M for the Near Term Energy-Efficient Technologies (NTEET) program; and \$555.0M for the Homeowner's Assistance Program (HAP). On August 10, 2010, Congress rescinded \$260.5M of Recovery Act funds in Public Law 111-226, reducing the total DoD Recovery Act funding to \$7.175B. Total obligations to date reflect over 7,500 contract actions with non-Federal vendors. Over 61% of contract actions have been awarded to small businesses (37% of contract dollars). The Department of Defense (DoD) had a net increase in outlays of \$13.8M during the week ending October 21, 2011, bringing the cumulative outlays of Recovery Act funds to \$5,158.0M, which is 71.9% of appropriated DoD Recovery Act funds. This includes \$3,487.3M for FSRM which had an increase in outlays of \$11.5M; \$778.2M for MILCON which had new outlays of \$1.9M; \$76.1M for ECIP which had new outlays of \$0.2M; \$261.4M for NTEET which had new outlays of \$0.3M; and \$555.0M for HAP. The increase in MILCON-TMA obligations included \$16.9M for a hospital alteration project at Fort Carson, CO and \$54.0M for a 4 hospital alteration project at Eglin AFB, FL.
