1	<p>The Department of Defense (DoD) had obligations of \$6.3M during the week ending October 23, 2009, bringing the cumulative obligation of Recovery Act funds to \$3,375.0M, which is 45.4% of available DoD Recovery Act funds. This includes \$2,605.6M for the Facilities Sustainment, Restoration and Modernization (FSRM) program which had net obligations of \$5.8M this week; \$582.1M for the Military Construction program; \$143.8M for the Near Term Energy-Efficient Technologies (NTEET) program; \$36.2M for the Energy Conservation Investment Program (ECIP); and \$7.2M for the Homeowners Assistance Program including \$0.4M in new obligations. Total obligations to date reflect over 2,550 contract actions with non-Federal vendors. Over 76% of contract actions were to small businesses (58% of contract dollars).</p>	<p>Continue to award contracts and monitor execution.</p>
2	<p>There were an additional \$5.8M in new obligations on FSRM projects for the week including \$5.4M for Defense -wide projects; \$1.1M for Army projects. For the week, Defense-wide obligations included \$3.0M to modernize a medical laboratory at Fort Leavenworth, KS; and \$1.8M to replace chilled water pumps in Building E3081- Institute for Chemical Defense at Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD. The Army obligations included \$0.9M for heating, ventilation and air conditioning upgrades at the welcome center at Fort Wainwright, AK; and \$0.2M for renovations of a company headquarters facility at Fort Richardson, AK.</p>	
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
