1	The Department of Defense (DoD) had a net increase in obligations of \$1.7M for the week ending July 08, 2011, resulting in cumulative obligations of the Recovery Act funds of \$6,806.6M, which is 94.8% of appropriated DoD Recovery Act funds. This includes \$3,992.2M for the Facilities Sustainment, Restoration and Modernization (FSRM) program; \$1,854.2M for the Military Construction (MILCON) program including \$1.6M in new obligations for the week; \$107.3M for the Energy Conservation Investment Program (ECIP); \$297.9M for the Near Term Energy-Efficient Technologies (NTEET) program; and \$555.0M for the Homeowner's Assistance Program (HAP). On August 10, 2010, Congress rescinded \$260.5M of Recovery Act funds in Public Law 111-226, reducing the total DoD Recovery Act funding to \$7.175B. Total obligations to date reflect over 6,700 contract actions with non-Federal vendors. Over 65% of contract actions have been awarded to small businesses (40% of contract dollars). 2	The Department of Defense (DoD) had net outlays of \$27.1M during the week ending July 08, 2011, bringing the cumulative outlays of Recovery Act funds to \$4,822.9M, which is 67.2% of appropriated DoD Recovery Act funds. This includes \$3,296.2M for FSRM which had new outlays of \$20.6M; \$607.1M for MILCON which had new outlays of \$7.3M; \$120M for ECIP which had a decrease of \$3.7M as a result of a reconciliation correction; \$244.6M for NTEET which had new outlays of \$2.9M for the week; and \$555.0M for HAP.
